3.Recording the same, the Writ Petition stands dismissed. No costs.

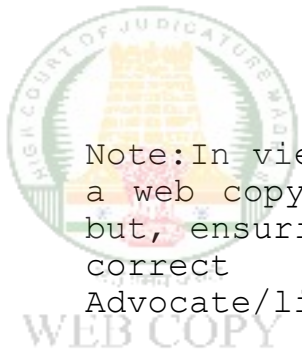
