PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

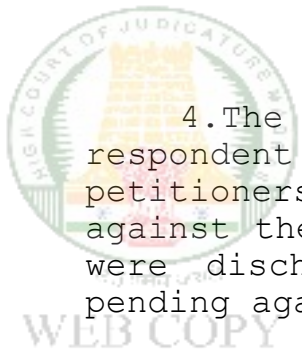
For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.200 of 2022 on the file of the Respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners/Accused, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 147, 294(b), 323, 427, 324, 506(ii) I.P.C, in Crime No.200 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that there was land dispute between the parties, on 05.06.2022 when the defacto complainant was in his field, the accused persons came there and made a wordy quarrel and prevented him from doing work in the land. Again, when the defacto complainant went to his house, the accused persons came there and assaulted the defacto complainant and his wife with hands and sickle. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted the defacto complainant is the relative of the petitioners and there is a property dispute between them. It is a case in counter, based upon the complaint given by the petitioners, a counter case was registered in Crime No.199 of 2022 against the defacto complainant party and that injured was discharged from the hospital. Hence, prays to release them on anticipatory bail.



4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent would submit that based upon the complaint given by the petitioners, case in counter was registered in Cr.No.199 of 2022 against the defacto complainant party and in both the cases injured were discharged from the hospital. There is no previous cases pending against the petitioners.

5.Considering the property dispute between the parties, that in both the cases injured were discharged from the hospital, that the petitioners are not having any previous case at their credit and it is a case in counter, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

6.Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Manapparai, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
