This petition has been filed to modify the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.O.P(MD).No.1002 of 2022 dated 31.01.2022 that the petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs.75,000/- (Rupees Seventy Five Thousand only) to the credit of the District Mineral Foundation Trust, Tirunelveli.



2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted the petitioner is not in a position to mobilize the fund within a time frame fixed by this Court.

3. Heard the learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) appearing for the respondent police.

4. On perusal of the records, it shows that this Court after considering the quantity of sand and hearing the both side arguments, imposed the above said condition. There is no reason to modify the said condition. Accordingly, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is dismissed and the time granted by this Court vide order dated 31.01.2022 in Crl.O.P(MD) No.1002 of 2022 is extended further for a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
