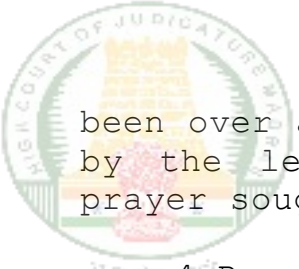
ORDER
