Prayer :-

Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, praying to direct the learned Judicial Magistrate No. I, Kovilpatti, Thoothukudi to expedite the trial and dispose of the case in D.V.C. No. 09 of 2020 within the period that may be stipulated by this Hon`ble Court.

ORDER:- This Criminal Original Petition coming on for orders on this day and upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon perusing letter D.No.1678/2022 dated 14.10.2022 from Judicial Magistrate No.I, Kovilpatti, this Court made the following order:

The Criminal Original Petition in Crl.O.P(MD) No.10811 of 2022 was filed by the Petitioner seeking direction from this Court to direct the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Kovilpatti to expedite the trial in D.V.C.No.9 of 2020.

2. This Court by an order dated 17.06.2022 had directed the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Kovilpatti to dispose the case in D.V.C. No.9 of 2020 within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Kovilpatti in his letter in D.No.1678 of 2022 dated 14.10.2022 had sought extension of time to dispose the case.

3. As per the remarks offered by the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Kovilpatti the copy of the order was received on 14.07.2022. Further the Petitioner has given the list of witnesses to be examined on 03.10.2022. It is the submission of the learned Magistrate that at the instance of the Petitioner appearing before the Court, there is delay in disposing the case.



4. In the light of the remarks offered by the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Kovilpatt further time of three months is granted to dispose the case pending in D.V.C. No.9 of 2020
