PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.86 of 2022 on the file of the Respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Accused No.2, who was arrested on 05.05.2022 for the alleged offences under Sections 452, 342, 294(b), 355, 394, 397 & 506(ii) of IPC, in Crime No.86 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 04.05.2022, at about 9 p.m., two accused persons entered into the defacto complainant's house and at the knife point, stolen a sum of Rs.15,000/- and two ATM cards and also attacked him. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He would further submit that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 05.05.2022.

4.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) appearing for the respondent police submitted that during the course of investigation Rs.9,000/- has been recovered from the petitioner and also submitted that no previous case is pending against this petitioner. He further submitted that the most of the investigation has been completed.



5. Considering the facts and circumstances of this case, of the investigation might have been over and considering the period of incarceration, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate Court, Periyakulam, Theni District, and on further condition that the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. and 5.30 p.m until further orders.
