Pursuant to the notice issued by this Court, the Tahsildar, Kallikudi Taluk, had undertaken the field visit and confirms that allegations made by the petitioner herein. Therefore, the second respondent as well as the sixth



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respondent are directed to take cognizance of the petitioner's complaint and take consequential action.”

2.In view of the said direction, no further order is required in this writ petition. However, the authorities concerned are directed to take effective follow up action.

3.The writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
