ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) for the respondent police submits that petition enquiry is pending and no case has been registered against the petitioners so far. He further submits that it is a matrimonial dispute between the husband and wife.
