PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.366 of 2022 on the file of the Respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Accused, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Section 379 I.P.C r/w Section 21(1) of Mines and Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957, in Crime No.366 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner has illegally transported 2 bags of black stone chips by using the vehicle. Therefore, the present case came to be registered.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case. However, to show his *bona fide*, the petitioner has come forward to pay a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) to the credit of Cr.No.366 of 2022 before the trial Court concerned.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondent police submitted that the petitioner has transported mineral illegally. He further submitted that there is no previous case pending against the petitioner herein.
