PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

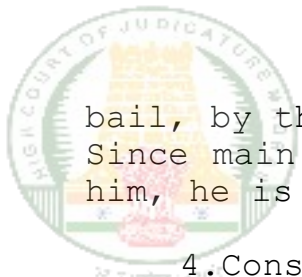
PRAYER :-For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.6/2022 on the file of the respondent police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Accused No.2, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 498(A) & 506(i) IPC, in Crime No.6 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the marriage between the defacto complainant and the first accused was performed on 02.07.2022, as per the religious custom. After that, they were living separately. There was cordial relationship between herself and the first accused. Later, discontinued the matrimonial affair. When that was enquired, he demanded Rs.10 lakhs as dowry. She was also abused, assaulted and criminally intimidated and at one point of time, she noticed that the first accused having affair with some other lady. That was also objected by the first accused. She picked up quarrel. If brought to the notice of the first petitioner did not take care and did not give proper advise to the first accused. Later, the first accused separated living with the petitioner. When there, she tried to contact the first accused, the petitioner said to have abused her in filthy language and criminally intimidated her. She was also physically assaulted by the petitioner. On that ground, present case has been registered.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the first accused, who is the husband has been granted anticipatory



bail, by this Court, in Crl.OP(MD)No.8566 of 2022, dated 06.07.2022. Since main accused has been granted anticipatory bail, according to him, he is only father-in-law, the same may be extended to him.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that the first accused has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.1V, Madurai, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
