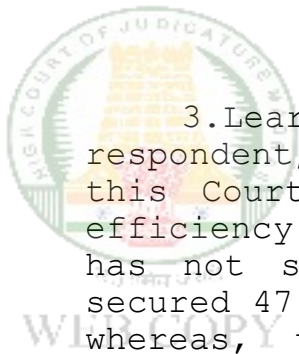

O R D E R

The petitioner has filed this writ petition as against his rejection and for a consequential direction to the respondent to permit him to participate in the next phase of selection, ie., the physical efficiency test.

2.It appears that this Court, by interim order dated 09.10.2020, has directed the respondent to permit the petitioner to participate in the physical efficiency test.



3.Learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondent, on instructions, submitted that pursuant to the order of this Court, the petitioner was permitted to attend the physical efficiency test conducted on 10.10.2020. Even then, the petitioner has not secured the required cut-off marks. The petitioner has secured 47.5 marks in the written test and physical efficiency test, whereas, the last selected candidate has secured 48.5 marks. Therefore, the petitioner was not selected for the subsequent phase of selection for the post of Sub-Inspector of Police.

4.The aforesaid submission made by the learned Additional Advocate General stands recorded. Since the prayer in the writ petition itself is for permitting the petitioner to participate in the physical efficiency test, which has already been granted and availed by the petitioner, no further order is required to be passed in this writ petition. Accordingly, the same is closed. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions stand closed.
