ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent police submitted that based upon the complaint given by one Michael Rubi, the complaint has been registered in CSR.No.139 of 2022. During the course of enquiry, it was found that civil dispute is pending between the parties and the defacto complainant gave a statement that she will resolve the issue before the concerned authority. Therefore, the respondent police closed the complaint.
