PETITION FOR BAIL under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.72 of 2022 on the file of the Respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order:-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as A1 was arrested, on 15/05/2022 and remanded to judicial custody for the alleged offences punishable under sections 8(c), 20(b), (ii) (B) of NDPS Act @ 8(c) of NDPS Act, in Crime No.72 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 02/04/2022 at about 05.00 pm, on a secrete information furnished by the informer, the police team went near Pasumpon Railway Gate, two persons were identified by the police informer. They were apprehended. At that time, one person ran away from that place and another person was apprehended. He disclosed that his name is Shebik. On search, it was found that ganja oil that was seized by following the procedures. Based upon the above said occurrence, it was found that oil is 1.36 kilograms, the case was altered to section 8(c) r/w 20(b) (ii) (B) of the Act.



3. Seeking bail, the petitioner, who is arrayed as A1 has filed this petition on the ground that it is a false case. He moved bail application before the trial court that was also came to be dismissed on 15th June 2022 on the ground that section 37 of the NDPS Act has not complied. Except stating it is a false case no other ground worthy considering has been raised in this case.

4. In the result, these criminal original petitions are **dismissed**.
