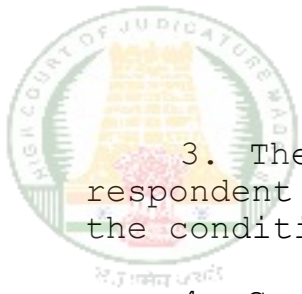
Prayer in CRL A(MD). 490/2019 :
