PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Cr.No.311/2022 on the file of the respondent police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner is facing charges under Section 328 IPC and Section 24(1) of Cigarette and other Tobacco Products Act, 2003 in Crime No.311 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police.

2.On the previous occasion, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) submitted that the petitioner is having previous bad antecedents. On that ground, he was directed to produce relevant records.

3.Today, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) for the respondent has produced a copy of the judgment in C.C.No.295 of 2018 on the file of the learned 2nd Additional District Munsif, Thoothukudi, wherein the petitioner was arrayed as A4 and was acquitted from the charges. Apart from that, the petitioner is involved in another two cases, which involves IPC offences also and was already disposed of.

4.In the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5.Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest on his appearance, before the learned Judicial Magistrate



No.I, Kovilpatti, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
