PRAYER :-

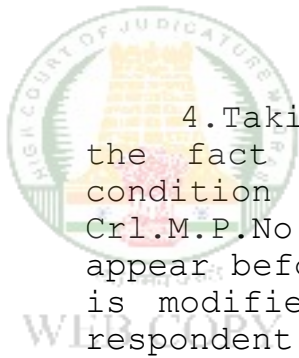
To relax the condition imposed by the learned District and Sessions Court, Madurai in Crl.M.P.No.2349 of 2022 dated 06.06.2022.
