PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :- For Bail in Crime No.40 of 2022 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners/Accused herein, who were arrested on 14.06.2022 for the alleged offence under Sections 4(1)(aaa), 4(1-A) of Tamil Nadu Prohibition Act, 420, 468, 471 of IPC, in Crime No.40 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seek bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 13.06.2022, the petitioners were found in possession of 215 liters of liquors. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. The petitioners also filed an undertaking that they will not commit any similar offence in future. Hence, prays for bail.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioners are having one previous case at their credit.



5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the affidavit filed by the petitioners that they will not indulge in any offence in future and also considering the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners with stringent conditions.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail, on executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Manamadurai, on further condition that the petitioners shall also file an undertaking affidavit before the trial Court that they will not indulge in any offence in future and on further condition that the petitioners shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders.
