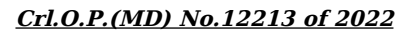

ORDER

This Criminal original Petition has been filed to direct the third respondent to accord adequate Police Protection to the life and limb of the petitioner based on the complaint given by the petitioner on 20.06.2022.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that there is a pathway dispute pending between the petitioner and the fourth respondent, due to which, the fourth respondent said to have waylaid the petitioner and abused him by using filthy language and also attacked him with aruval. Thereafter, the petitioner had sent a complaint to the respondents 1 to 3 to take action. Since no action has been taken, the present Criminal Original Petition has been filed.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondents 1 to 3 submitted that after receiving the complaint from the



4. On perusal of the materials available on records, it is seen that there is a dispute between the petitioner and the fourth respondent with regard to the right of way over the land. The fourth respondent is the adjacent land owner of the land in dispute and he has given trouble to the petitioner. Hence, he gave a complaint before the third respondent and C.S.R.No.141 of 2022 has been filed. The third respondent enquired the matter. During the enquiry, the third respondent recorded the statements of the local persons residing near the place of occurrence and come to conclusion that there is no such occurrence took place as stated by the complainant, hence, closed the complaint.



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5.Recording the same, this Criminal Original Petition is closed.
