PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.137 of 2022 on the file of the Respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Sole Accused, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 324, 506(ii) of IPC and Section 4 of TNWH Act, in Crime No.137 of 2022, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that pursuance of previous enmity, on 04.06.2022, the accused person came to the defacto complainant's house and abused her grant daughter in filthy language and also tried to assault her with knife, in which the defacto complainant and her grant daughter were injured. Based on the above said occurrence, case has been registered.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submitted that trouble arose between the parties due to the marriage arranged was broken down because of some elopement issue. The injured person has been discharged from the hospital.



5. Considering the nature of offence, the overt act against the petitioner and the injured person has been discharged from the hospital, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Sivagangai, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
