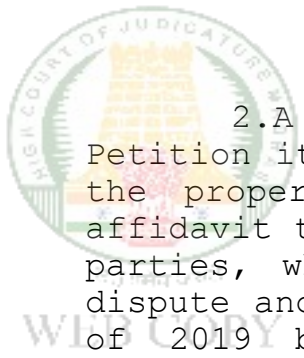

It is the contention of the petitioner in the affidavit that her husband's sisters have sold the property to third parties, who are causing trouble to her. When there is a civil dispute and the suit in this regard is already pending in O.S.No.96 of 2019 before the District Munsif Court, Vadipatti, without assigning any rights, no blanket directions could be issued.
