The petitioner has spent a sum of Rs.2,66,290/- towards the surgery undergone by him. Further he has made application to the sixth respondent seeking reimbursement under the Scheme. However, the application is kept pending without any order being passed. Therefore, the petitioner is before this Court.

3.The learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents submits that the application of the petitioner is under consideration and appropriate orders would be passed within the time specified by this Court.

4.In view of the above, the respondents are directed to consider the application of the petitioner and pass appropriate orders within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.

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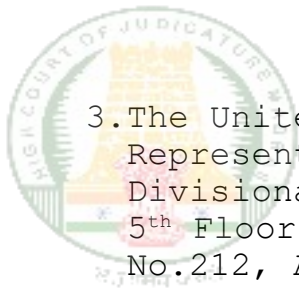
