2. Recording the same, this Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs.

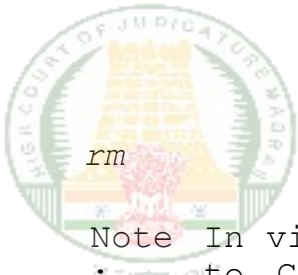
