Prayer in WP(MD). 23359/ 2019 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of certiorarified Mandamus Calling for the records of the impugned order of the 1st Respondent in O.Mu.No.2897/A2/2019 dated 01-07-2019 and quash the same and consequently direct the 1st Respondent to approve the sanction of yearly increment from 16-07-13 and refix the scale of pay as per the 7th pay commission and pay all monetary benefits within the time fixed by this Honourable Court.

Prayer in WP(MD). 23338/ 2019 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a writ of certiorarified Mandamus Calling for the records of the impugned order of the 1st Respondent in O.Mu.No.6200/A2/2018 dated 08-01-2019 and quash the same and consequently direct the 1st Respondent to approve the sanction of yearly increment from 01-07-2018 by the 2nd Respondent and refix the scale of pay as per the 7th pay commission and pay all monetary benefits within the time fixed by this Honourable Court.
