This writ petitioner filed this Writ Petition seeking for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the third respondent to permit the petitioner to conduct Kabbadi Tournament from 22.07.2022 at about 6 PM to 24.07.2022, 6 P.M. at Komakudi Village, Lalgudi Taluk, Trichy District.

2.Mr.M.Sakthi Kumar, learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) takes notice for the respondents. By consent, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has decided to conduct Kabbadi Tournament, which is scheduled to be held from 22.07.2022 at about 6 PM to 24.07.2022, 6 P.M. at Komakudi Village, Lalgudi Taluk, Trichy District. Hence, he sought permission of the police by giving a representation dated 15.07.2022. But, the respondents have not considered the said representation. Since no order was passed, the petitioner has come before this Court for the above said relief.

It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai had issued a circular memorandum in Rc. 007301/Genl.I (1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting sports. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the third respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 15.07.2022 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.
