Prayer in CRL A(MD). 352/ 2022 :

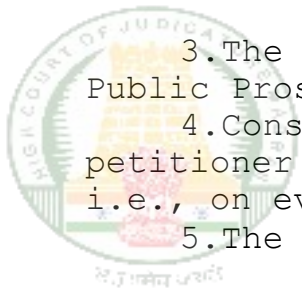
