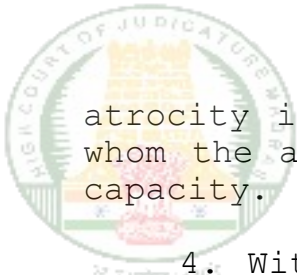

Being aggrieved, the present writ petition is filed as if the Sub Inspector of Police, namely, Arun and others wrongfully entered into the house of the petitioner and brutally attacked the petitioner and her family members.

3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor further submits that the present writ petition filed seeking compensation alleging police
