This writ petitioner filed this Writ Petition seeking for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to grant permission and protection for Adal Padal Program perform in Mulaikottu Vizha scheduled to be held on 26.07.2022 at Arulmigu Sri Muthumariamman Thirukovil at Thangachimadam, Ramanathapuram District.

2.Mr.M.Sakthi Kumar, learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) takes notice for the respondents. By consent, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the Adal Padal Program scheduled to be held on 26.07.2022 at Arulmigu Sri Muthumariamman Thirukovil at Thangachimadam, Ramanathapuram District. Subsequent to the same, in order to conduct the Adal Padal Programme, they sought permission of the police by giving a representation dated 11.07.2022. But, the second respondent has not considered the said representation. Since no order was passed, the petitioner has come before this Court for the above said relief.

It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai had issued a circular memorandum in Rc. 007301/Genl.I (1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the second respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 11.07.2022 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.
