PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No. 95 of 2022 on the file of the Respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Sole Accused, who was arrested on 03.06.2022 for the alleged offences under Sections 451, 195(A) and 506(ii) IPC, in Crime No.95 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that ib 02.06.2022 at about 01.00 hours, the petitioner trespassed into the house of the defacto complainant and threatened her and her daughter to give evidence in favour of him and demanded to solemnize a marriage between him and her granddaughter. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He would further submit that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 03.06.2022.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) for the respondent submitted that the final report has not been filed so far.



5. Considering the facts and circumstances of this case, at most of the investigation is over, considering the fact that within few days, the petitioner is entitled to statutory bail and also considering the period of incarceration, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

5. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Rajapalayam, and on further condition that the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders.
