PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.Not Known of 2022 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners/Accused (Rank Not Known), apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 406, 420 and 498(A) IPC and Section 3 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961, in Crime No.Not Kown of 2022 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.
