2.Recording the said submission, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed as infructuous.

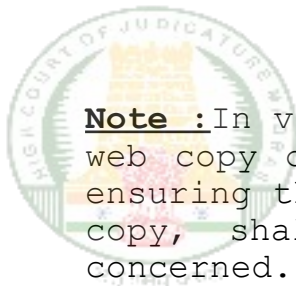
