2. In view of the above submission and endorsement made, this writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn. No costs.

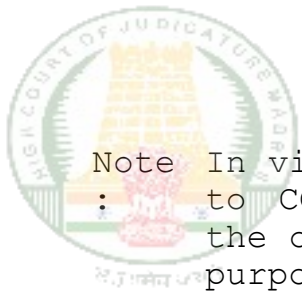
