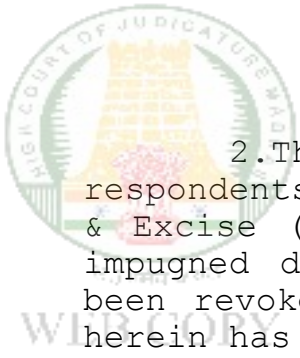
ORDER

The petitioner is the mother of the detenu, namely, Baladhandayuthapani, S/o.Saminathan, aged about 27 years. The detenu has been detained by the second respondent by his proceedings in C.O.C.No.16/2021 dated 02.09.2021, holding him to be a "Bootlegger", as contemplated under Section 2(b) of Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982. The said order is under challenge in this Habeas Corpus Petition.



2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents by producing a copy of G.O.Rt.No.5540, Home, Prohibition & Excise (XV) Department, dated 19.11.2021, would submit that the impugned detention order in C.O.C.No.16/2021 dated 02.09.2021 has been revoked by the Advisory Board. Hence, the prayer sought for herein has become infructuous.

3.Recording the same, this Habeas Corpus Petition is dismissed as having become infructuous.
