



Court, Tirunelveli, convicting the petitioner under Sections 408, 477-A and 204 IPC sentenced him to undergo one year Simple Imprisonment, to pay a fine of Rs.100/- in default to undergo 3 months Simple Imprisonment.

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and peruse the material placed before this Court.

3. A perusal of the documents which shows that the petitioner did not surrender before the trial Court as per the order of the trial Court made earlier. Hence, there is no question of granting suspension of sentence to the petitioner at this stage itself. Hence this Court is of the view, that the petitioner is not entitle for suspension of sentence and hence this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is dismissed.
