2. This criminal original petition has been filed for quashing the First Information Report in Crime No.180 of 2015 registered on the file of the first respondent.

3. The defacto complainant Ms.Ranjitham is present before this Court through video conferencing. She has been duly identified by Mr.M.Karuppan, SSI, attached to the first respondent police station and the same has been duly confirmed by Mr.M.Sakthi Kumar, learned Government Advocate. The parties have filed a joint compromise memo. The defacto complainant states that she does not want to pursue the matter.

4. Since the defacto complainant herself does not want to pursue the matter, no purpose will be served in keeping the impugned prosecution alive. Therefore, the impugned First Information Report



is quashed. This criminal original petition is allowed. The joint compromise memo dated 02.12.2021 shall form part of the record. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
