Prayer in CRL MP(MD) . 9529/ 2022 :

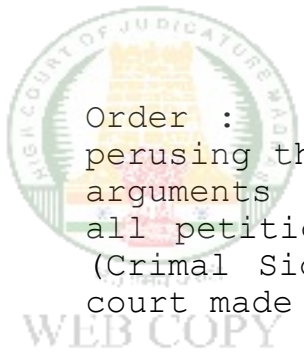
