PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 67 of 2022 on the file of the Respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Accused, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 341,294(b),323,506(i) of IPC r/w.Section 4 of TNPHW Act in Crime No.67 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. Earlier bail application filed by the petitioner was dismissed on the ground that the petitioner involved in previous case. Now the second application was filed on the ground that the defacto complainant was one of the accused. It is a matrimonial dispute and the petitioner was not involved in the above said occurrence.

3. It is also submitted that the petitioner is involved in a case in crime No.98 of 2019 for the offence under Section 307 of IPC. Hence the learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) was directed to produce the copy of the First Information Report. According to the learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) there was a case and case in counter for which FIR in Crime No.99 of 2019 was registered.
