ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections
294(b), 323 and 506(i) IPC and Section 4 of TNPHW Act, in Crime
No.125 of 2021, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to previous motive,
the petitioner abused the defacto complainant in filthy language and
also attacked him in the public place. Therefore, the present case
came to be registered.

3.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned
Government Advocate(Crl.side) appearing for the respondent police.
