PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the second respondent to grant permission and adequate police protection to conduct Innisai Katcheri on 19.08.2022 and other programmes schedule in the invitation for 3 days i.e., from 18.08.2022 to 20.08.2022 on the eve of “Arulmigu Murampadi Sri Sudalai Thalavai Madasamy Temple” festival situated in Pannamparai, Sathankulam, Tuticorin District, based on the petitioner's representation dated 12.08.2022 within the time limit that may stipulated by this Court.

ORDER

This writ petitioner filed this Writ Petition seeking for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the second respondent to grant permission and adequate police protection to conduct Innisai Katcheri on 19.08.2022 and other programmes schedule in the invitation for 3 days i.e., from 18.08.2022 to 20.08.2022 on the eve of “Arulmigu Murampadi Sri Sudalai Thalavai Madasamy Temple” festival situated in Pannamparai, Sathankulam, Tuticorin District, based on the petitioner's representation dated 12.08.2022 within the time limit that may stipulated by this Court.

2.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) takes notice for the respondents. By consent, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that there is a festival in the temple, by name, Arulmigu Murampadi Sri Sudalai Thalavai Madasamy Temple situated in Pannamparai,



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Sathankulam, Tuticorin District, from 18.08.2022 to 20.08.2022.

Subsequent to the same, in order to conduct a cultural programme on 19.08.2022, they sought permission of the police by giving a representation dated 12.08.2022. But, the respondents have not considered the said representation. Since no order was passed, the petitioner has come before this Court for the above said relief.

4.The learned Government Advocate (criminal side) appearing for the respondent police would submit that the respondents have received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

5. I have considered the submission of the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (criminal side) appearing for the respondent police.

6. It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai had issued a circular memorandum in Rc.007301/Genl.I (1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme.



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Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the third respondent is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 12.08.2022 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.

7. With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of.
