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The petitioner is the detenu, namely, Iruthayayowan, S/o.Siluvai Alangaram, aged about 38 years. The detenu has been detained by the second respondent by his proceedings in M.H.S.Confdl. No.147/2021 dated 15.09.2021 holding him to be a "Goonda", as contemplated under Section 2(f) of Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982. The said order is under challenge in this Habeas Corpus Petition.

2. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent, by producing a copy of G.O.Rt.No.5871, Home, Prohibition & Excise (XIV) Department, dated 30.11.2021, would state that the impugned detention order has been revoked and hence, the prayer sought for in this Habeas Corpus Petition has become infructuous.

3. Recording the same, this Habeas Corpus Petition is dismissed as having become infructuous.
