2.Recording the same, this writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs.

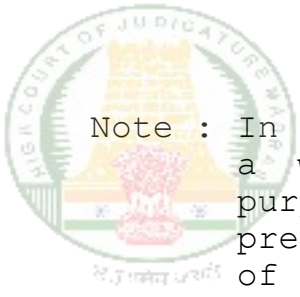
