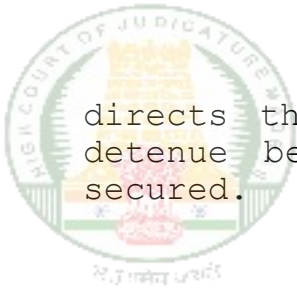

3.The status report filed by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor reveals that the detenue is a mentally affected person and the police have launched a thorough search in the area in and around Rameswaram.

4.It is seen from the status report filed by the Inspector of Police, Rameswaram that there is no suspected illegal detention. Hence, this Habeas Corpus Petition is closed. However, this Court

detenue before the jurisdictional Magistrate as and when he is
