Prayer :- Writ Petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this court to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents 3 and 4 to grant permission and protection to the petitioner to celebrate Vinayagar Sathurthi Festival on 31.8.2022 at Cumbum Town by placing 108 Vinayagar Idols mentioned in the representation dated 16.08.2022 and for procession to be held on 01.09.2022 from Arasamaram, Cumbum Town to Mullai Periyar River and thereby render justice

Order: This Writ Petition came up for hearing on 30.08.2022 and disposed of on the same day and subsequently the case posted under the caption "For Being Mentioned" on this 1st day of September Two Thousand and Twenty Two in the presence of Mr.D.Maialichamy, Advocate for the Petitioner and of Mr.Veerakathiravan, Additional Government Advocate, General Assisted by Mr.M.Veerendhran, Government Advocate,



this Court made the following order:-

This case is posted today under the caption "for being mentioned", at the instance of the learned counsel for the writ petitioner.

2. The learned counsel for the writ petitioner would submit that though they have installed the idols, they are not permitted to take the idols for immersion and that necessary direction may be issued to the respondent authorities to grant permission to them for the same.

3. The learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondents would submit that since they have violated the conditions, the concerned authorities have passed the detailed orders rejecting the requisition of the writ petitioner.

4. The learned counsel for the writ petitioner would submit that they are ready to give a fresh representation to the concerned Inspector of Police seeking permission to take the idols for immersion.

5. In view of the above, the writ petitioner is directed to give fresh representation to the concerned police authorities and on such filing, the third respondent is directed to consider the representation and pass necessary orders in the manner known to law.
