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2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.M.Sakthi Kumar, learned Government Advocate (Crl. side), appearing for the respondents.

Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (crl. side) appearing for the respondents submitted that the petitioner gave a complaint against the 5th respondent herein and the same was registered a case in Crime No.128 of 2020.
