4.At this juncture, the learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is ready to send fresh complaint to the respondents 1 and 2.



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5.In view of the above, the petitioner is directed to give fresh complaint to the respondents 1 and 2 and on such complaint, the respondents 1 and 2 are directed to proceed with the enquiry and complete the same in accordance with law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.With the above directions, this Writ Petition stands disposed of.
