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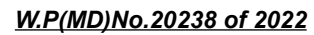

ORDER

This writ petitioner filed this Writ Petition seeking for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant permission to celebrate the Vinayagar Chathurthi Festival and to place Vinayagar Idols temporarily in the premises of Arulmugu Sri Vinayagar Temple, Eliyarpatti, Valayankulam, Thirupparankundram, Madurai District, that is scheduled from 31.08.2022 to 01.09.2022 based on the petitioner's representation, dated 16.08.2022.

2. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice for the respondents. By consent, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

In view of the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner is directed to file an affidavit as aforesaid and on filing of the same, the respondents are directed to grant permission by imposing conditions specified in the Government Order in G.O.(Ms)No. 598, Public (Law & Order-B) Department, dated 09.08.2018.



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7. With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No cost.
