ORDER

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This petition has been filed to direct the learned Principal District Judge, Karur, to accept the surrender of the petitioner and consider the bail application on the date of his surrender in connection with Crime No.155 of 2022 on the file of the 2nd respondent Police.

2.The petitioner is the sole accused in Crime No.155 of 2022 on the file of the 2nd respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 324, 506(i) IPC, r/w Section 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) and 3(2) (va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

3.Mr.A.Albert James, learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. He submitted that no previous case is pending against the petitioners and the injured person in this case has been discharged from the hospital.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders :-

1)The petitioner shall appear before the learned Principal District Judge, Karur, within a period



of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

2)On such surrender along with notice served to the defacto complainant, the concerned Judge shall consider the bail application filed by the petitioner and pass orders on merits on the same day of their surrender, after hearing the defacto complainant by complying with Section 15A(5) of the Act.

5.With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
