2.The said G.W.O.P.Nos.196 and 197 of 2014 were filed by the appellants under Section 29 of the Guardians and Wards Act 1890, to permit them to sell the immovable properties of their minor children, which were dismissed by the learned IV Additional District Judge, Tirunelveli. 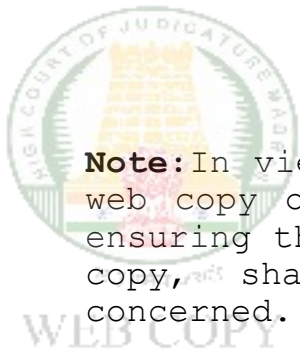
