2.When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) would submit that based on the complaint given by the first petitioner's husband Seetharaman, enquiry was undertaken in C.S.R.No.830 of 2022 and during the course of enquiry, the first petitioner has stated that she has issued a legal notice to the complainant and she will workout her remedy through appropriate proceeding. So, on that basis, the C.S.R was closed on 30.08.2022. Since as on date, no complaint is pending against the petitioner and now the matter has become infructuous.



3. Recording the submission made by the learned Government Advocate(Crl.side), this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of as infructuous.
