### **ORDER**

2. Heard Mr.S.Vinothkumar, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.M.Sakthi Kumar, learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), appearing for the respondents.

3. When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (crl. side) appearing for the respondent police submitted that the respondent police has prepared a plan for permitting the idol procession through some non-problematic area and they have no

objection to permit the idol procession in non-problematic area marked by the respondent police. The statement is recorded.

5. With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No cost.
