Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the 1st respondent to rectify the UDR error in respect of the property comprised in S.No.432/2A, 432/2B, 432/2C, 432/2D, 432/2E, 432/2F situated at Poiyundarkottai Village, Orathanadu Taluk, Thanjavur District upon conducting a detailed enquiry within a stipulated time by considering the petitioner's representation dated 31.12.2108 and 01.09.2021.

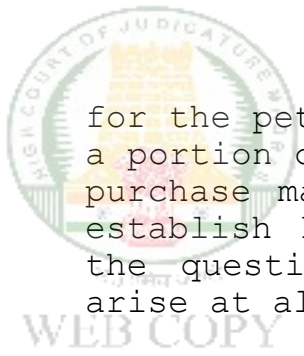

ORDER

Heard the learned counsel on either side.

2.The petitioner wants the error that crept in during UDR to be rectified. The learned Additional Government Pleader for the respondents points out that even before UDR, the petition mentioned survey numbers reflected the names of the petitioner and three others. In other words, on account of UDR, there was no change in the status quo and the position that earlier remain continued. Therefore, the question of directing the District Revenue Officer to rectify any UDR error does not arise at all. The learned counsel



for the petitioner states that he has exclusive title and claim over a portion of the petition mentioned survey numbers on account of the purchase made by him. In that event, it is for the petitioner to establish his case only before the jurisdictional civil Court and the question of directing the District Revenue Officer does not arise at all.

3. Leaving open the petitioner's rights, the writ petition is dismissed. I make it clear that I have not gone into the merits of the matter. The outcome of this writ petition will not in any way cast any cloud on the petitioner's rights. No costs.
